ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to receive a Shirley and Billy Weir scholarship, an applicant must: (1) be the employee or the dependent child of an employee of a golf course facility located within the State of Georgia served by a golf professional who is a member of The Georgia Section of the PGA of America; (2) must have maintained a high school grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or corresponding grade point level if another grade point scale has been adopted by his or her high school); (3) must demonstrate financial need; (4) must have been accepted for admission to an accredited college or university (the Scholarship Selection Committee may elect to approve a student's scholarship conditioned upon the student's acceptance); and (5) must be graduating from high school during the school year of application. Accordingly, it will be necessary for each applicant to provide proof of his or affiliation with an approved golf course facility, high school grade point average, acceptance for admission and proof of his or her financial need based upon the student's parents' federal income tax returns and other relevant information that the student elects to submit to the Scholarship Selection Committee. The applicant must be prepared to participate in a personal interview on dates announced by the Scholarship Selection Committee.

Note: You may not apply for this scholarship if you are a relative of one of the Trustees or a relative of one of the members of the Scholarship Selection Committee of the Shirley and Billy Weir Scholarship Foundation Trust. A relative is defined to include a spouse, child, grandchild, great-grandchild, or a spouse of a child, grandchild or great-grandchild.
